STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend section eleven of chapter two hundred and eleven of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety five, as amended by chapter one hundred and one, of the laws of nineteen hundred and nine, relating to salaries of Judge and Recorder of Bangor Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section eleven of chapter two hundred and eleven 2 of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred 3 and ninety five, as amended by chapter one hundred and one 4 of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and 5 nine is further amended by striking out the words "fifteen 6 hundred" in the eighth line and inserting the words 'eight-7 een hundred' and by striking out the words "fourteen 8 hundred and fifty" in the ninth line and inserting in the

9 place thereof the words 'fifteen hundred' and by striking 10 out all of the section after the word "Penobscot" in the 11 eleventh line so that said section as amended shall read as 12 follows.

'Sect. 11. Said court shall be held at such place as the city of Bangor shall provide and said city shall have poewr and it shall be its duty to raise money and provide a proper looplace for said court and its officers and suitably furnish, warm and light the same, for which there shall be paid from the county of Penobscot, as rental in quarterly payments, the sum of one thousand dollars annually. The salaries of the Judge and clerk thereof which are hereby fixed at eighter een hundred dollars and fifteen hundred dollars respectively, to be paid quarterly, with all other expenses of said court, shall be paid from the treasury of the county of Penobscot.'
