STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE for aid in building a highway bridge across Carrabassett River in the town of Kingfield.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum 2 of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the purpose of aid-3 ing in the building of a bridge across the Carrabassett river 4 in the town of Kingfield where the chain bridge is now sit-5 uated, provided that there be appropriated by the town of 6 Kingfield or otherwise the sum of five thousand dollars 7 (\$5,000) for the same purpose, both sums to be expended 8 under the supervision of the State Highway Commission, 9 and further provided that any additional cost of said bridge 10 above fifteen thousand dollars shall be borne by the town of 11 Kingfield, and also that said bridge shall be kept in such re-12 pair, as may be directed by the State Highway Commission, 13 by the town of Kingfield.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This bridge is on the main highway running from Patten to Island Falls through said town of Crystal, and has been designated as a State Aid road in said town. There are three bridges on this road, all three of which it is necessary to rebuild this present year. Said town is a sparsely settled community of farmers, and has a long mileage of road to maintain.
