STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of repairing a highway in the town of
Solon.

Resolved: that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum
2 of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300) for the purpose of re-
3 pairing a highway in the town of Solon, Somerset County,
4 provided there be appropriated by the town of Solon the sum
5 of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300) for the same purpose;
6 both sums to be expended under the provision of the State
7 Highway Commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This is the main highway from Solon to Brighton, a distance of thirteen miles. The road is a mail route and is used by teams of two Creameries. It is the principle route for the produce of a large territory to a railroad station. The section of road for which this appropriation is asked is known as Hunnewell Hill and is almost impassable at certain seasons.
