IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Nine of Chapter Sixty-nine of the Revised Statutes Relating to the Authority of Guardians of Persons over Twenty-one Years of Age.

Be it enacted by the Pcople of the State of Maine, as follows: Section nine of chapter sixty-nine of the revised statutes
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "guardians"
3 in the first line of said section, the following words, 'shall
4 give notice of their appointment and make return thereof to
5 the probate court in the manner provided by law relating to
6 notices of appointment by executors and administrators,' so
7 that said section as amended shall head as follows.

'Sect. 9. Such guardians shall give notice of their ap-9 pointment and make return thereof to the probate court in

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10 the manner provided by law relating to notices of appoint-11 ment by evecutors and administrators. They have the cus-12 tody of the persons of their wards, if resident in the state, 13 except so far as the court of probate may from time to time 14 otherwise order; and every guardian appointed over any 15 person for gambling, idleness, drinking or debauchery, shall 16 inculcate upon him habits of sobriety and industry, and 17 when of sufficient health and strength, with the approbation 18 of the judge, may bind him out to labor, not exceeding six 19 months at any one time, or employ him in his own service; 20 giving credit for his earnings, or such sum as he receives 21 therefor.'
