STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Twenty-five of Chapter Three of the Revised Statutes as Amended by Chapter One Hundred and thirty-eight of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Five, Relating to the Printing of the Reports of the State Departments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section twenty-five of chapter three of the
2 revised statutes as amended by chapter one hundred and
3 thirty-eight of the public laws of nineteen hundred and five
4 is hereby further amended so as to read as follows:

'Sect. 25. The reports, catalogues and compilations of all 6 state departments, commissions and institutions may be

7 printed and bound, but the number and the styles in which 8 the same shall be so printed and bound, at the expense of 9 the state, shall be determined from time to time by the gov-10 ernor and council, who shall also fix the number of the 11 same which shall be delivered from the bindery or printing 12 office to the librarian of the state library: but the number 13 of reports of any department shall not exceed the limit 14 fixed by law for said department.'

Sect. 2. Section twenty-four of chapter three of the re-2 vised statutes and all amendments thereof are hereby re-3 pealed.
