STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section three of Chapter two hundred eighty-five of the Private and Special Laws of the year nineteen hundred eleven relative to the Water Rights of the Dover and Foxcroft Water District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section three of chapter two hundred eighty-five of the
2 private and special laws of the year nineteen hundred eleven
3 is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

'Sect. 3. Dover and Foxcroft Water District is hereby
5 authorized, for the purposes mentioned in its charter, to take
6 and hold sufficient water of Garland Pond, situated in Fox-
7 croft and Sebec, in the County of Piscataquis, and may raise
8 the waters of said pond by a dam at the outlet thereof, to

9 such a height as said district may deem expedient, and it
10 is further hereby authorized, for said purposes, to create an
11 artificial pond, by damming the waters of Meadow Brook,
12 so called, by a dam situated at any convenient point on said
13 brook, in one or more of lots five and six in Ranges three
14 and four in said Foxcroft which dam may, be of such height
15 as said district may deem expedient, and may take and hold
16 by purchase or otherwise, any land or real estate necessary
17 for erecting dams, and flowage caused thereby, power, res-
18 ervoirs, or for preserving the purity of the water, and water-
19 sheds, and for maintaining a way or ways from the public
20 highways to said ponds, and for laying and maintaining aque-
21 ducts for conducting, discharging, distributing, and disposing
22 of water.'
