STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, assenting to the provisions of An Act of the Congress of the United States, approved May 8, 1914, entitled "An Act to Provide for Co-operative Agricultural Extension Work between the Agricultural Colleges in the several states receiving the benefits of the Act of Congress approved July 2, 1862, and of Acts supplementary thereto, and the United States Department of Agriculture."

Whereas, the Congress of the United States has passed an Act approved by the President, May 8, 1914, entitled "An Act to Provide for Co-operative Agricultural Extension Work between the Agricultural Colleges in the several States receiving the benefits of the Act of Congress approved July 2, 1862, and of Acts supplementary thereto, and the United States Department of Agriculture," and

Whereas, it is provided in section 3 of the Act aforesaid, that the grants of money authorized by this Act shall be paid annually “to each state which shall by action of its legislature assent to the provisions of this Act,” therefore, be it

Resolved, by the Senate and House of Representatives, That
2 the assent of the Legislature of the State of Maine be and is
3 hereby given to the provisions and requirements of said act,
4 and that the trustees of the University of Maine be and they
5 are hereby authorized and empowered to receive the grants
6 of money appropriated under said Act, and to organize and
7 conduct agricultural extension work which shall be carried
8 on in connection with the College of Agriculture of the Uni-
9 versity of Maine in accordance with the terms and conditions
10 expressed in the Act of Congress aforesaid.
