AN ACT to Amend Chapter thirty-one of the Revised Statutes
by Including Shooting Galleries in the Provisions Thereof.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section three of chapter thirty-one of the re-
vised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word
"bowling alley" in the first line thereof the words 'shooting
gallery,' and by inserting after the word "alley" in the sec-
ond line thereof the word 'gallery', so that said section as
amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 3. Whoever keeps a bowling-alley, shooting gallery,
pool, bagatelle or billiard room without a license forfeits ten
dollars for each day that such alley, gallery or room is so
kept.'

Sect. 2. Sections four to eight, both inclusive, of said
2 chapter thirty-one shall apply to and shall include shooting
3 galleries and the keepers thereof.
