STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to Exempt Neat Stock Thirty Months Old and Under and all Sheep and Swine from Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Article V of section 6 of chapter 9 of the revised statutes

- 2 is hereby amended by striking out the words "neat cattle,
- 3 sheep and swine" in the first line; also by changing the period
- 4 at the end of the sentence to a comma, and by adding the fol-
- 5 lowing words: 'and neat cattle thirty months old and under
- 6 and all sheep and swine,' so that said article V as amended
- 7 shall read as follows:
- 'V. All mules and horses less than six months old, and g neat cattle thirty months old and under and all sheep and to swine.'
