STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section one of Chapter 251 of the Special
Laws of 1907, as amended by chapter 28 of the Special Laws
of 1909, entitled An Act for the better protection of alewives,
shad and sturgeon in the various rivers in Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter two hundred and fifty-one of the
2 private and special laws of nineteen hundred and seven, as
3 amended by chapter twenty-eight of the special laws of nine-
4 teen hundred and nine is hereby amended by striking out all
5 after the word "bridge" in the third line, so that said section
6 as amended shall read as follows:

‘Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to take,
8 catch, kill or destroy any alewives, shad or sturgeon in the
9 waters of the Kennebec River above the Randolph and
10 Gardiner bridge.’
