STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to fix the salaries of the judge and recorder of the
Eastport Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The judge of the Eastport Municipal Court
2 shall receive as compensation an annual salary of nine hun-
3 dred dollars payable quarterly from the county treasury
4 of the county of Washington, on the first days of January,
5 April, July and October.

He shall account quarterly under oath, to the treasurer
7 of said county for all fees received by him or payable to him,
8 by virtue of his office, specifying the items and shall pay
9 the whole amount of the same to the treasurer of the county
10 of Washington.

Sect. 2. The recorder of the Eastport Municipal Court
2 shall receive as compensation an annual salary of one hun-
3 dred dollars payable quarterly from the county treasury of
4 the county of Washington, on the first days of January,
5 April, July and October.

All fees collected by him shall be paid over to the county
7 treasurer.
