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STATE OF MAINE

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AN ACT to regulate the employment of subordinates by Leg-  
islative Committees.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The Governor and Council shall, by a general  
2 order, to be revised at the beginning of each session of the  
3 Legislature, determine which of the Legislative committees  
4 may have the service of subordinates and in what capacities,  
5 and shall fix the compensation to be paid to such subordi-  
6 nates.

They shall also from time to time during the session of the  
8 Legislature when found necessary authorize other necessary  
9 assistance to the committees.

Sect. 2. No Legislative committee, or officials chosen by  
2 such committee shall employ clerks, stenographers, or other  
3 clerical help, at the expense of the state, until so authorized

4 by the Governor and Council and the subordinates employed  
5 by such authority shall receive no other compensation from  
6 the state than that fixed by the Governor and Council.
