STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to Extend the Rights, Powers and Priveleges of the
Barrows Falls Light and Power Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The rights, powers and priviledgs of the Barrows Falls
2 Light and Power Company, which were granted by
3 chapter two hundred and sixty-three of the private and
4 special laws of the year nineteen hundred and nine, and
5 extended by chapter two hundred and sixty-seven of the
6 private and special laws of nineteen hundred and eleven,
7 and extended by chapter one hundred and fifty-five of the
8 private and special laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen,
9 are hereby extended for and during the period of two
10 years from the date on which this act takes effect, and the

11 rights, powers and privileges that were granted by said
12 act may and shall be exercised in the same manner and for
13 the same purposes as provided in said act.
