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RESOLVE, in favor of James J. Clement of Montville.

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*Resolved,* That the sum of two hundred dollars be and  
2 hereby is appropriated to be paid to James J. Clement of  
3 Montville for the expense incurred by him in the 77th  
4 legislature because of his seat in the House of Representa-  
5 tives having been contested by Peter Harmon of Thorndike,  
6 and that the same be appropriated and paid as a part of  
7 the legislative expenses of the state legislature.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

James J. Clement was duly returned by the governor and council as entitled to a seat in the 77th legislature. Notice of contest was filed by Peter Harmon of Thorndike, and the case heard by the House Committee on Elections was determined that said claimant was entitled to his seat by a majority of two votes. The above expenses were incurred by said Clement in presenting his case before the committee.
