STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section ten of Chapter twelve of the Revised Statutes for the Benefit of County Law Libraries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section ten of chapter twelve of the revised statutes as
2 heretofore amended is hereby further amended by adding
3 to said section the following sentence: 'The treasurer of
4 each county shall also pay to the treasurer of the law library
5 association of his county all money received from persons
6 admitted as attorneys in the supreme judicial court upon
7 motion, without a certificate from the board of examiners
8 of applicants for admission to the bar,' so that said section
9 as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 10. The treasurer of each county, except the county
11 of Lincoln, shall annually pay to the treasurer of the law
12 library association of his county, for the uses and benefits
13 of the county law library, the sum of five hundred dollars.
14 The treasurer of the county of Lincoln shall annually pay
15 to the treasurer of the law library association of his county,
16 the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars. The treasurer
17 of each county shall also pay to the treasurer of the law
18 library association of his county all money received from
19 persons admitted as attorneys in the supreme judicial court
20 upon motion, without a certificate from the board of exam-
21 iners of applicants for admission to the bar.'
