STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, authorizing the land agent to sell and convey a certain lot or parcel of land, situated in the public lot of Dennistown Plantation, in Somerset county.

Resolved, That the land agent is hereby authorized to sell
2 and convey to the present occupant thereon a certain lot
3 or parcel of land in Dennistown plantation in Somerset coun-
4 ty, constituting part of the school lot of said plantation, if
5 he deems advisable, for such price per acre and for such
6 terms of payments as he may deem advantageous; provided,
7 that the proceeds of such sale made shall be added to the
8 school fund of said plantation.

AMENDMENT "A" TO HOUSE DOCUMENT NO. 119.

Amend title by striking out the words "sell and convey"
2 and inserting the word 'lease' so that the title as amended
3 shall read as follows:

'Resolve, authorizing the land agent to lease a certain lot
5 or parcel of land, situated in the public lot of Dennistown
6 plantation in Somerset county.'

Amend the resolve by striking out the whole of said resolve
8 and inserting in place the following:

Resolved, That the land agent is hereby authorized to lease
10 to the present occupant thereon a certain lot or parcel of
11 land in Dennistown plantation in Somerset county, con-
12 stituting part of the school lot of said plantation, if he deems
13 advisable, at such price and terms of payment, to be ad-
14 justed every five years, as he deems advantageous; provided,
15 that the proceeds of any leases shall be paid annually by the
16 treasurer of state to the treasurer of said plantation to be
17 expended under the direction of the superintending school
18 committee for the support of the common schools therein.'
