IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to ice fishing in Harlow pond, in Parkman, in the county of Piscataquis.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
So much of section two of chapter thirty-two of the re-2 vised statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and
3 six of the public laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen,
4 as prohibits fishing through the ice for pickerel, in accord-5 ance with the general law of the state relating to ice fish-6 ing, in Harlow pond, in Parkman, in the county of Pis-7 cataquis, is hereby repealed.
