STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to Enlarge the Purposes of the New England Fish Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: The New England Fish Company, a corporation existing 2 under the general laws of the State of Maine, is hereby 3 authorized and empowered to engage in and carry on, the 4 following business in addition to that named in, and au-5 thorized by, its certificate of organization, to wit: All kinds 6 of mercantile, manufacturing, mechanical, mining and quar-7 rying business; the carriage of passengers and freight, or 8 both, upon any waters where said corporation may legally 9 navigate; and also in places and states (other than the State

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10 of Maine) where permissible under the laws thereof, to 11 engage in the construction and operation of railroads, tele-12 graph and telephone lines; the generating, selling and dis-13 tributing of water power, gas and electricity for lighting, 14 heating, manufacturing, mechanical, or other uses.
