STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend the Charter of Penobscot Bay Electric
Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The action of said Penobscot Bay Electric
2 Company in purchasing the plant, property, rights, priv-
3 ileges and franchises of Searsport Electric Company is
4 hereby ratified, approved and declared legal and valid and
5 said Penobscot Bay Electric Company shall have, possess,
6 exercise and enjoy in its own name said plant, property,
7 rights, privileges and franchises as though originally grant-
8 ed to it, except that it shall have no authority to issue fur-
9 ther stock, securities or obligations of any kind in the
10 name of said company.

Sect. 2. Said Penobscot Bay Electric Company is hereby
2 authorized and empowered to purchase the plant, property,
3 rights, privileges and franchises of Greenville Light and
4 Power Company including those acquired by purchase from
5 Wilson Stream Dam Company, Dover & Foxcroft Light
6 and Heat Company, Sangerville Improvement Company and
7 Sebec Power Company, excepting only the property, rights,
8 privileges and franchises comprising its water system by
9 means of which water is supplied to the town of Greenville
10 and to Township No. 3, Range 5, East of Kennebec River
11 in Bingham's Kennebec Purchase, commonly called Little
12 Squaw Mountain Township, and the said Greenville Light
13 and Power Company is hereby authorized and empowered
14 to sell its plant, property, rights, privileges and franchises
15 as above mentioned, to the Penobscot Bay Electric Company
16 and after purchase of any such plant, property, rights,
17 privileges and franchises, said Penobscot Bay Electric Com-
18 pany shall have, possess, exercise and enjoy in its own name,
19 said plant, property, rights, privileges and franchises as
20 though originally granted to it.
