STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend the Charters of the Thomaston Street Railway Company, the Rockland Street Railway Company, and the Camden & Rockport Street Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 12 of the charter of the Thomaston Street Railway Company, which is Sec. 12, Chap. 323 of the private and special laws of 1889; Sec. 12 of the charter of Rockland Street Railway Company, which is Chap. 346 of the private and special laws of 1889; Sec. 12 of the charter of the Camden & Rockland Street Railroad Company, which is chapter 409 of the private and special laws of 1889, are each and all hereby repealed; and the Rockland, Thomaston & Camden Street Railway, which has succeeded to the

10 rights, privileges, immunities and liabilities of said several
11 corporations, shall have the same rights and be subject to
12 the same liabilities as though said sections had never been
13 a part of the charters of said respective railroad companies,
14 or of the charter of said Rockland, Thomaston & Camden
15 Street Railway.
