STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of aid in repairing the international bridge
between the towns of Van Buren, Maine, and St. Leonards,
New Brunswick.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) for the purpose of
3 aiding in painting and replanking the international bridge
4 across the St. John river between the towns of Van Buren,
5 Maine, and St. Leonards, New Brunswick; said appropria-
6 tion to be contingent upon an equal sum to be furnished
7 by the Canadian Government for the completion of the
8 work. Said appropriation shall be expended under the su-
9 pervision of the State Highway Commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The international bridge between Van Buren, Maine, and St. Leonards, New Brunswick, which was built in 1910, under a special resolve of the legislature, is now in need of re-painting and re-planking.

The Department of Public Works, of the Canadian Government, are asking for an appropriation of \$3,000 for the maintenance of their portion of this bridge and this resolve is asked in order that the part of the bridge constructed by the State of Maine may be put in proper repair at the same time.
