STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to create a Crop Pest Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. A "Crop Pest Commission," consisting of the

- 2 Governor of the State, the Attorney General of the State,
- 3 the Commissioner of Agriculture, the Pathologist of the
- 4 Maine Agricultural Experiment Station, and the Entomolo-
- 5 gist of the Maine Agricultural Experiment Station, is here-
- 6 by created.

Sect. 2. This commission may direct the Commissioner of

- 2 Agriculture to make such regulations as are deemed neces-
- 3 sary to prevent the introduction into the State of Maine, or
- 4 the dissemination therein, of any insect, pest or plant dis-
- 5 ease seriously injurious to vegetation.

Sect. 3. In this act and in any regulation made therein 2 "Vegetation" shall mean any tree, shrub, vine, vegetable or 3 other plant, or the product, or any other portion of the tree, 4 shrub, vine, vegetable or other plant; "Nursery Stock" shall 5 mean all fruit and ornamental trees, shrubs and vines, and 6 it shall include currant, gooseberry, blackberry and rasp-7 berry bushes.

Sect. 4. This act does not repeal any of the existing laws 2 relating to the protection of trees and shrubs.
