STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Bureau of Horticulture.

Resolved, That for the purpose of carrying into effect all 2 provisions of the law now in force, or as the same may be 3 amended, and added to, relative to the Bureau of Horticul-4 ture, there is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the 5 treasury the sum of five thousand dollars for the year one 6 thousand nine hundred and fifteen, and five thousand dol-7 lars for the year one thousand nine hundred and sixteen. . .

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The duties of the Bureau of Horticulture consist of the inspection of nurseries, inspection of orchard and shade trees, inspection of nursery stock coming into the state from outside the state, demonstrations in various phases of orchard work, lecture work, publishing reports, short articles and bulletins along the lines of horticulture, granting of licenses for selling nursery stock, and the granting of certificates of inspection of nurseries in the state.
