STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Chapter 233 of the Private and Special Laws of 1913 relating to the salary of the Judge of the Municipal Court in the Town of East Livermore.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirteen of Chapter one hundred and twenty-nine
2 of the Private and Special Laws of Eighteen hundred nine-
3 ty-nine as amended by Section one of Chapter two hundred
4 and thirty-three of the Private and Special Laws of nine-
5 teen hundred thirteen is hereby further amended by strik-
6 ing out the words "four hundred" in the fourth and fifth
7 lines of said amended section thirteen and inserting in place
8 thereof the words 'six hundred,' so that said section shall
9 read as follows:

‘Sect. 13. All fees, civil and criminal, shall inure to the
11 County of Androscoggin and shall be paid over to the treas-
12 urer of said county by said judge on the first day of each
13 month. The judge of said court shall receive an annual sal-
14 ary of six hundred dollars, payable quarterly on the first
15 days of April, July, October and January from the treasury
16 of Androscoggin County.’
