STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT relating to the accounts of the various State Examining Boards and to provide for the bonding of all officials and clerks who handle public moneys.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. All fees paid into the state treasury by the
2 board of registration of medicine, commissioners of phar-
3 macy, board of examiners of applicants for admission to
4 the bar, board of dental examiners, state board of embalm-
5 ing examiners, state board of veterinary examiners, Maine
6 state board of registration and examination in optometry,
7 and the Maine board of accountancy, shall constitute con-

8 tinuous carrying accounts to be used for the payment of
9 the salaries, per diem and expenses of said several boards.

Sect. 2. All persons employed in the several state depart-
2 ments and institutions who handle public moneys, and the
3 treasurer of each of the examining boards named in the pre-
4 ceding section, shall, on and after the date this act shall
5 take effect, give bond in such sum as may be fixed by the
6 governor and council to properly account for all funds com-
7 ing into their hands. The premiums on account of such
8 bonds shall be paid by the state from the proper appropri-
9 ations of said departments, institutions, boards, or commis-
10 sions.
