STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Two of Chapter Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as An. Indeed by Chapter Two Hundred and Six of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Thirteen, Relating to Ice Fishing in Lower Kezar pond, in the town of Fryeburg in Oxford County, and in the town of Bridgton, in Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

So much of section two of Chapter thirty-two of the revised 2 statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the 3 public laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, as prohibits 4 fishing through the ice for pickerel and black bass, in accord-

5 ance with the general law of the State relating to ice fishing, 6 in Lower Kezar pond, in the town of Fryeburg, in Oxford 7 county, and in the town of Bridgton, in Cumberland county, 8 is hereby repealed.
