STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, Providing for a Laboratory Building for the State Board of Health.

Resolve, That the sum of Twenty Thousand dollars be and
2 hereby is appropriated for the purpose of erecting upon the
3 State House grounds, and in such location as may be desig-
4 nated by the Governor and Council, a building to be used by
5 the State Laboratory of Hygiene, which is under the super-
6 vision of the State Board of Health, said sum, or so much
7 thereof, as may be needed for the erection, equipment, and
8 furnishing of said building to be expended by the director of
9 the laboratory and the laboratory Committee of the State
10 Board of Health under the approval of the Governor and
11 Council.
