RESOLVE, in favor of Frederick Brown.

*Resolved, That Frederick Brown, an employee of the State  
2 of Maine, who served as Night Watch at the State House  
3 for a continuous period of twenty-six years from 1886 to  
4 1912, be retired on half pay; the amount per week to be one-  
5 half the pay he received per week during his last year of  
6 service for the state.*
