AN ACT Relating to Fees Received by Clerks of Courts in
Naturalization Proceedings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The clerks of the judicial courts in the several counties shall
2 not be required to account quarterly to the county treasurer
3 for fees collected by them in naturalization proceedings
4 under the act of congress of June twenty-nine, nineteen hun-
5 dred and six, as amended by the act of June twenty-five,
6 nineteen hundred and ten.
