STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to authorize the removal of bodies of deceased persons from the Guilford Cemetery on the highway leading from Guilford Village to Foxcroft, in the town of Guilford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The town of Guilford is hereby empowered to authorize
2 some suitable person to take up from the old cemetery in
3 the town of Guilford, on the highway leading from Guilford
4 village to Foxcroft, the bodies and remains of all deceased
5 persons buried therein, and all headstones and markers at
6 the graves therein, and remove the said bodies and remains
7 to Elmwood cemetery, in said town, and there decently inter
8 the same, and properly reset such headstones and markers
9 over such dead bodies and remains at the expense of said
10 town.
