AN ACT additional to chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to fishing in Bent's pond, so called, in the town of New Sharon, in Franklin County, and in the town of Vienna, in Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

For a period of four years from the time this act takes 2 effect no person shall fish for, take, catch, kill or destroy 3 any kind of fish at any time in Bent's pond, so called, in the 4 town of New Sharon, in Franklin county, and in the town 5 of Vienna, in Kennebec county.

No person shall have in possession at any time any kind 7 of fish taken in violation of any provision of this act.

Whoever violates any provision of this act shall pay a fine 9 of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty dollars and 10 costs of prosecution for each offense; and in addition there11 to one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or had in 12 possession in violation of any provision of this act.
