STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend chapter 32 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 206 of the public laws of 1913, relating to fishing in the Davis ponds, in Guilford and Willimantic, in the county of Piscataquis.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

So much of section two of chapter thirty-two of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the public laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, as prohibits fishing through the ice in the four Davis ponds, so called, in Guilford and Willimantic, in accordance with the general law of the State relating to ice fishing is hereby repealed.
