STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Maine School for the Deaf.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated to be 2 paid the Maine School for the Deaf the sum of twenty-eight 3 thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and fifteen, 4 and the sum of twenty-eight thousand dollars for the year 5 nineteen hundred and sixteen, both of said sums for main-6 tenance and running expenses, and twelve thousand dollars 7 for the year nineteen hundred and fifteen for the purchase 8 of land and buildings for girls' dormitory and hospital.
