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AN ACT Relating to the Payment of Legacies.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Legacies shall be payable in one year after the death of  
2 the testator; but such payments shall not be affected by any  
3 claims presented to the executor, or administrator with the  
4 will annexed, or filed in the probate office, after the expira-  
5 tion of said one year and after such payment; nor shall the  
6 executor or administrator with the will annexed be respon-  
7 sible for the payment of said legacies on account of such  
8 claims, unless he has failed to give notice of his appointment  
9 as required by law and the judge of probate.
