STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT Relating to the Payment of Legacies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Legacies shall be payable in one year after the death of 2 the testator; but such payments shall not be affected by any 3 claims presented to the executor, or administrator with the 4 will annexed, or filed in the probate office, after the expira-5 tion of said one year and after such payment; nor shall the 6 executor or administrator with the will annexed be respon-7 sible for the payment of said legacies on account of such 8 claims, unless he has failed to give notice of his appointment 9 as required by law and the judge of probate.
