IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to Punish Escapes from Jail.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Whoever, being lawfully detained for any criminal offense,
2 in any jail or other place of confinement, breaks or escapes
3 therefrom, or forcibly attempts to do so, shall be punished,
4 if such prisoner was in custody for a felony, by imprison-
5 ment for not less than one, nor more than seven years; and
6 if for any other offense, by imprisonment for not exceeding
7 one year; such imprisonment shall commence after the com-
8 pletion of any sentence imposed for the crime for which he
9 was then in custody.
