IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section 10 of Chapter 116 of the Revised
Statutes relating to Compensations of Fish Wardens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 10 of chapter 166 of the revised statutes is amended
2 by striking out the word "two" in the first line and inserting
3 in place thereof the words 'two dollars and fifty cents,' so
4 that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 10. The pay of fish wardens shall be two dollars
6 and fifty cents a day and expenses when actually employed.
7 The governor and council shall audit their accounts and
8 cause the same to be paid from the state treasury.'
