STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to make part of each election day a holiday.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

On the days upon which fall the election of state officers
2 and the election of any and all national officers, the time
3 from twelve o'clock noon to two o'clock in the afternoon of
4 said days shall be observed as a holiday. During such pe-
5 riod of time, on said days, any and all places of business,
6 where voters are employed, shall be closed.

Any and all persons and the officers of any and all cor-
8 porations violating the provisions of this act, shall upon
9 conviction be liable to a fine of not less than one hundred

10 dollars and not more than one thousand dollars for each
11 offense, the same to be recovered upon complaint or indict-
12 ment in manner and form as is prescribed for other crimi-
13 nal offenses.

The provisions of this act shall not apply to transporta-
15 tion companies wherever by so doing the regular service
16 of such company would be affected.
