House Amendment A to House Document 450.

Amend by striking out all after the enacting clause and 2 inserting in place thereof the following:

Section one of chapter ten of the Revised Statutes

- 4 is hereby amended by inserting a colon in place of the 5 period, and by adding the following words: 'provided, how-
- 6 ever, that the poll taxes shall be due and payable on May
- 7 first and commitment of the lists of poll tax payers shall be
- 8 made to the collector prior to that date,' so that said section
- 9 shall read as follows:

'Section 1. Towns, at their annual meetings, may deter-II mine when the lists named in section eighty-four of chap12 ter nine shall be committed, and when their taxes shall be
13 payable, and that interest shall be collected thereafter: pro14 vided, however, that the poll taxes shall be due and payable
15 on May first and commitment of the lists of poll tax payers
16 shall be made to the collector prior to that date.'
