STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Two of Chapter Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as Amended by Chapter Two Hundred and Six of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Thirteen, Relating to Ice Fishing in Lake Kezar, in the towns of Lovell, Stoneham and Stow, in Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
So much of section two of chapter thirty-two of the Re2 vised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six
3 of the public laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, as pro4 hibits fishing through the ice for pickerel, cusk and smelts,
5 in accordance with the general law of the State relating to
6 ice fishing, in Lake Kezar, in the towns of Lovell, Stone7 ham and Stow, in Oxford county, is hereby repealed.
