#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT Additional to Chapter Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as Amended by Chapter Two Hundred and Six of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Thirteen, Relating to Fishing in the Tributaries to Lake Kezar and in the tributaries to Kezar river, in the County of Oxford.

#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall fish for, take, catch or kill any 2 kind of fish, except smelts and suckers, at any time above 3 the dead water in any of the tributaries to Lake Kezar, in 4 the towns of Lovell, Stoneham and Stow, in the county of 5 Oxford, nor shall any person fish for, take, catch or kill any 6 kind of fish at any time in any of the tributaries to Kezar

7 river, in the towns of Lowell and Sweden, in said county.

No person shall have in possession at any time any kind 9 of fish taken in violation of any provision of this section.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of section one of 2 this act shall pay a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more 3 than thirty dollars and costs for each offense; and in addition thereto one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or 5 had in possession in violation of any provision of said section.
