STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE. To appropriate Five hundred Dollars for the construction of approaches to the State Ferry at Eggemoggin Reach.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be and is
2 hereby appropriated for the construction of team and auto-
3 mobile approaches to the State ferry at Eggemoggin Reach
4 in the Towns of Deer Isle and Sedgwick in the County of
5 Hancock. The same to be expended under the direction of
6 the State Highway Commissioners.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

As the ferry is at present, it is impossible for automobiles to get on board except at high water. This is a great inconvenience to the people who wish to patronize that ferry.
