STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to repeal chapter one hundred and sixty-three of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and nine, relating to the hunting of water fowl and wild birds in Back Bay, Portland.
