STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT authorizing Seboeis Plantation to build and maintain
its roads and bridges and to raise money therefor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The municipal officers of Seboeis plantation in the county
2 of Penobscot, are hereby given all the powers of municipal
3 officers of towns to lay out, alter, widen or repair public
4 of private ways within said plantation, and to assess and
5 expend such sums of money as said plantation may at its
6 annual meeting raise therefor, in all respects as the municipal
7 officers of towns may do; and so far as applicable the pro-
8 visions of chapter twenty-three of the revised statutes shall
9 apply to laying out, extending, altering, or repairing public

10 or private ways in said plantation; and all the powers which
11 towns now have to raise and expend money for the purpose
12 of making and repairing ways, building bridges, and paying
13 officers and agents, are hereby extended to said plantation.
