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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

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AN ACT authorizing Barnard Plantation to build and main-  
tain its roads and bridges and to raise money therefor.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

The Municipal Officers of Barnard Plantation in the Coun-  
2 ty of Piscataquis, are hereby given all the powers of Mu-  
3 nicipal Officers of towns to lay out, alter, widen or repair  
4 public or private ways within said Plantation, and to assess  
5 and expend such sums of money as said Plantation may at  
6 its annual meeting raise therefor, in all respects as the Mu-  
7 nicipal officers of towns may do; and so far as applicable  
8 the provisions of chapter twenty-three of the Revised Stat-

9 utes shall apply to laying out, extending, altering, or repair-  
10 ing public or private ways in said Plantation; and all the  
11 powers which towns now have to raise and expend money  
12 for the purpose of making and repairing ways, building  
13 bridges, and paying officers and agents, are hereby extended  
14 to said Plantation.
