STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of a History of Pemaquid, of Bristol.

Resolved, That the State Librarian, under the supervision
2 of the Governor and Council, in conformity to the policy
3 of the state to aid in the publication and preservation of
4 its early history, be and hereby is authorized to purchase
5 three hundred (300) copies of the History of Ancient Pem-
6 aquid, entitled "Twenty Years at Pemaquid," for the library
7 and it is further

Resolved, That the sum of six hundred (600) dollars is
9 hereby appropriated for that purpose, and that the State
10 Librarian circulate these throughout the State Libraries and
11 High Schools and the remaining copies be distributed by
12 the Governor and Council.
