STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Chapter three hundred and fifty-six of the
Private and Special Laws of 1883 relating to construction of
bridge over tide waters between Orrs Island and Baileys
Island.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 2 of Chapter 356 of the private and Special Laws
2 of 1883 relating to the construction of a bridge over tide
3 waters between Orrs Island and Baileys Island is hereby
4 amended so that said section as amended shall read as fol-
5 lows:

Sect. 2. The municipal officers of the town of Harps-
7 well shall have all the powers relating to said bridge and its

8 construction which are provided by law in case of town
9 ways. If said municipal officers unreasonably neglect or re-
10 fuse to lay out and construct said bridge on petition of an
11 inhabitant, or of any owner of land therein, or the town un-
12 reasonably refuses to accept said bridge when laid out, the
13 petitioner or any person interested, may, within one year
14 thereafter, present a petition stating the facts to the Com-
15 missioners of Cumberland County, at a regular session, who
16 shall give notice thereof to all interested, and act thereon in
17 the manner provided by statute respecting highways. Any
18 person interested shall have the same right of appeal from
19 the decision of the County Commissioners as is provided by
20 Section 21 of Chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes.'
