STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT additional to chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to night hunting.

Be it enacted by the Pcople of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. There shall be a closed season on wild birds in
2 this State from sunset to sunrise of the following morning,
3 and on wild animals from one hour after sunset until one
4 hour before surrise of the following morning, during which
5 closed season it shall be unlawful to hunt, kill or destroy
6 wild birds or wild animals of any kind.

No person shall have in possession at any time any wild 8 bird or wild animal, or part thereof, taken in violation of 9 any provision of this section.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of section one of 2 this act shall pay a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more 3 than fifty dollars and costs for each offense; provided, how-4 ever that if protected wild birds or wild animals are hunted, 5 killed, destroyed or had in possession in violation of said 6 section the penalty shall be the same as is now imposed 7 therefor during other closed season.
