STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to regulate anchorage in waters of Moosehead Lake
bordering on Kineo.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No vessel of any description, steamboat, motor
2 boat, by whatever power propelled, houseboat, scow or raft
3 shall be allowed to anchor or moor and remain more than
4 twenty-four hours in the waters of Moosehead Lake de-
5 scribed in Section Two, after the owner, captain or person
6 in charge thereof has been notified by an official as author-
7 ized by Section Three, to leave the anchorage or mooring; in
8 case of immediate necessity, or upon failure to move forth-
9 with when so notified, said official shall have full authority

10 to move any craft to another safe anchorage, mooring or
11 landing place.

Sect. 2. The waters of Moosehead Lake bordering on the
2 southern shore of that part of Kineo Point lying southerly
3 of the top of Mt. Kineo and extending to the pavilion, in
4 Kineo, Piscataquis County, for a distance of four hundred
5 yards from any part of said shore line shall be subject to
6 the provisions of Section One.

Sect. 3. It shall be the duty of the steamboat inspectors
2 for the State of Maine to enforce the provisions of this Act,
3 and they may appoint for this purpose one or more deputies
4 domiciled at Kineo.

Sect. 4. This Act shall not apply to rafts of logs or tim-
2 ber moored or anchored while in transit across Moosehead
3 Lake.

Sect. 5. Whoever refuses to move when notified under the
2 provisions of Section One and Section Two, upon complaint
3 shall pay a fine of twenty dollars and costs for each offense,
4 and five dollars to the official who acts.
