STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT additional to chapter 41 of the revised statutes, amended, relating to the destruction of fish, in tidal waters, by means of dynamite or poisonous or stupefying substances.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall use dynamite or any poisonous
2 or stupefying substance whatever, for the purpose of de3 stroying or taking any kind of fish in tidal waters, under a
4 penalty of one hundred dollars and costs, and in addition
5 thereto, two months' imprisonment in the county jail, for
6 each offense.

Sect. 2. No person shall buy, sell, give away or expose for 2 sale or possess for any purpose any fish taken by use of dy-

- 3 namite or any poisonous or stupefying substance, and no
- 4 person while engaged in fishing shall carry in his fishing
- 5 boat or vessel, any dynamite or other explosives, nor any
- 6 stupefying substance.

Whoever violates the provision of this section shall be sub-8 ject to a fine of one hundred dollars and cost and in addi-9 tion there to shall be imprisoned for a term of sixty days.
